



872 - TWO WAY TUBE SWEATER

Beginner

7.0 mm needles, tapestry needle (for seams and to weave in ends)						
Stitch markers Ref. 683.951 (pack of 48)						

Stitches used

This design is created throughout by knitting together 1 strand of TEDDY & 1 strand of PLUME. Prepare the balls beforehand with the 2 yarns together, to ensure an even fur effect.

STOCKING ST (ST ST), using 7.0 mm needles:

Row 1 (RS): k

Row 2 (WS): p.

Repeat these 2 rows.

Tension/Gauge

To achieve a good result it is essential to make a tension square (see BASIC instruction pages at beginning of book.)

11 sts x 15 rows in St st = 10 cm (4 in) tension square.

To make

BACK:

Using 7.0 mm needles, cast on **49-53-57-61-67** sts with one ball. Work in St st until work measures **48-49-50-52-54** cm, (**19¼-19¾-20½-21¼** in), [**72-74-76-78-82** rows] total.

N.B.: Take all the measurements holding the work vertically.

Insert a stitch marker into the first and last sts to mark the beginning of the armholes (see diagram) and continue in St st.

When work measures **70-71-72-74-76** cm, (**27½-28-28¼-29-30** in), [**106-108-110-112-116** rows] total, insert a stitch marker in the first and last sts to mark the end of the armholes and continue in St st.

When work measures **104-107-110-113-116** cm, (**41-42-43¼-44½-45½** in), [**158-162-166-170-176** rows] total, cast off all the sts (see BASIC instruction pages at beginning of book) and cut the yarn leaving a **60** cm (**23½** in) length of yarn. This will be used to sew the seam.

FRONT:

Work as for back.

TO MAKE UP:

Join the side seams using an invisible seam (see BASIC instruction pages at beginning of book), leaving a 22 cm (8¾ in) opening (= between the 2 stitch markers) to allow for arms to go through.

Remove all the stitch markers.

Using the tapestry needle, sew in the yarn ends along the edge across several rows and cut off the excess yarn.

This tube sweater can be worn in 2 different ways: as a tunic or as a jumper with a more open collar, wearing it upside down.
